

Bowls club can start clean up thanks to Flood Fund grant

Workington Bowling Club has received £1,500 to rebuild the access road to their club.

"The road to the club is devastated. Without access the insurance cleaners and club members can't get on with the clean up" said Roger Hart, Community Foundation Grants Officer.

"The green looks OK and the damage to the pavilion is insured, but it's things like the road that aren't and that's where the Flood Recovery fund can really make a difference" he continued.
