What will the fund support?

Because funds available for distribution are limited, there is an expectation that supported activities will reflect the highest level of achievement and excellence. We would hope that activities also introduce artists' work to new audiences.

Examples of activities supported

- research on Cumbrian monuments and sculpture
- canvas and paint for MACFA Show
- dance tuition
- publication of photographic booklet

Decision making

Decisions are made by a specialist panel. The panel may wish to meet applicants to discuss and view their work.

When to apply

Applications are considered throughout the year.

How much can you apply for?

- There is no upper or lower limit but grants would usually be under £500
- If you wish to apply for a larger grant please talk to Foundation staff before applying
